Harvest Collection

This week, we spoke to the children about the Harrow Food Bank.

We don't think anyone in our community should have to face going hungry. That's why we want to support the work of the Foodbank as our harvest offering this year.



Harrow Foodbank provides three days' nutritionally balanced emergency food and support to local people who are referred to the charity in crisis. The Foodbank is part of a nationwide network of foodbanks, supported by The Trussell Trust, working to combat poverty and hunger across the UK.

This Monday, 14 October, we will be holding harvest assemblies during which we will invite children to bring in items from home to support the work of the foodbank. The Foodbank has provided a specific list of 10 items they would like us to collect:

- Packet Puddings (steamed)
- Packet meat soups
- Washing up liquid (small bottles)
- Toothbrushes (single – adults and children)
- Tomato Ketchup (small)
- Honey
- Bags for Life
- Tinned Chicken Meals
- All toiletries (male and female)
- Juice and Squash

Please help us by donating an item or two from the shopping list above and sending the items into school on Monday.

Extra help needed! We are also looking for some kind parents who can help us to transport our collection to the Harrow Foodbank. The Foodbank is based at the Phoenix Business Centre in Harrow (a 10 minute drive from School). If you can help, please let us know. The items will be available for collection from 10am on Monday morning (the Foodbank can receive the donations between 10.30am and 2pm on Monday).
