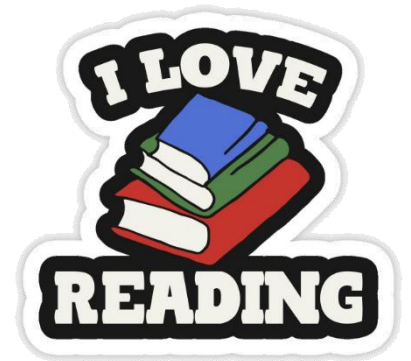
The [Book Trust](#) have a brilliant site which is jam-packed with books, book activities and book information. There's books, read-alouds, activities, games, recipes and much more!
