We're so pleased that everyone is making such a good effort with the home learning.

We know that it is not easy to teach children at home – many members of our staff team are discovering this too!

The weekly projects have a good range of activities which can be used flexibly during the week. Our latest 'Learning Projects' (Week 8) are now available online. The theme for this week is 'Around the World'. You'll notice that there is a slight change of format for this half term. In response to parent feedback, we've suggested daily activities for the core subjects. We've also added some suggested STEM (science, technology, engineering and maths) activities.

Parents of children in Reception, Year 1 and Year 6 have been sent details of their group by School Ping.

Arrangements for critical worker and vulnerable children will continue in their present format for all year groups.

We expect the schedule to continue in a similar pattern to the week beginning 8 June in the weeks that follow but we want the opportunity to review this in the light of any new government guidance (and the possibility of further widening to other year groups).

The school will be closed to most pupils each Wednesday to allow for rigorous cleaning and a changeover between groups.
