## Remembering a Nursing Great

On this day, 15 June, in 1860, the 'Nightingale School and Home for Nurses' opened its doors for the first time.

Florence Nightingale had become a national hero due to her extraordinary life-saving work as a nurse. The British public raised £50,000 in her honour - a vast amount of money in those times. With that money she founded the first-ever training school for nurses. From that time on, nurses were well-trained in medical care and the responsibilities of nursing.

Her legacy lasts, of course. There are still hospitals being opened in her name and, at this time more than ever, we are so grateful for her work, and for the work of all those nurses and others who work within the NHS.

To all those in our Pinner Park community who work as nurses or in other ways with the NHS, we thank you.

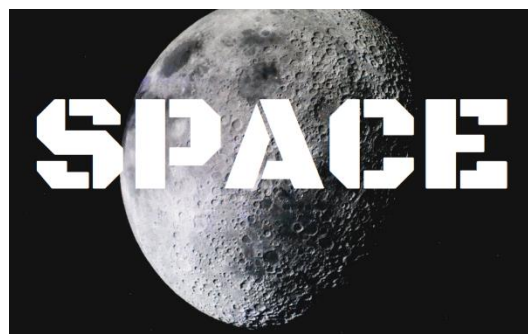
This week's assembly is led by some of Year 6 children. Well done everyone!
