English

Phonics / Spelling

- or sound spelt **a** before **l** and **ll**

Maths

Developing Calculation Skills:

Art & Design

Children will be investigating the landscape paintings of Henri Rousseau and will be planning and creating their own 3D landscape pieces using a range of recycled materials.



Computing

iAnimate – children will use computer software to create moving images from a series of still images just like their favourite cartoons.
E-safety – knowing that it is hard to remove information once it is online.



Design & Technology

Children will be investigating textiles this term. They will look at a range of techniques for joining materials for different purposes and they will look at how templates are used in textile design. They will plan and make their own textile product using these techniques.

Geography

Children will be completing a locality study about India and will be developing their understanding of the human and physical features of this incredibly vibrant nation.



History

Children will focus on a geography topic this half term before moving on to a geography topic next half term.

Languages

Children in Key Stage 1 are not required to learn an additional language as we focus on them developing their skills in English.

Music

Children will be listening to a range of music that helps to communicate a message to the audience. They will also work together to create and perform compositions which 'talk' to their audience.
