## Autumn (1) Term 2022

### English

**Spelling**

- Prefix (mis-, un-, in-, dis-, auto-, inter-)
- Words ending in *-zhuh* spelt *-sure* (pleasure, treasure)
- Short *u* sound spelt *ou*
- Suffix (-ly)

**Grammar and Punctuation**

- Adjectives, conjunctions, fronted adverbials
- Apostrophes

**Writing**

- Description, narrative, diary, advertisement, explanation

**Chosen Texts**

What We'll Build – Oliver Jeffers (whole school text)

### Maths

**Place Value**

- Represent and partition numbers to 1,000
- Represent and partition numbers to 10,000
- Find 1, 10, 100, 1,000 more or less
- Estimate, compare and order numbers to 10,000
- Roman numerals
- Round to the nearest 10, 100, 1,000

**Addition and Subtraction**

- Add and subtract 1s, 10s, 100s, and 1,000s
- Add and subtract two 4-digit numbers without or with exchanges
- Estimating answers and using checking strategies

### Art & Design

Linked to their learning in history, children will be looking the art of Ancient Egypt. With a focus on hieroglyphics, experimenting with media including watercolour and papyrus.



### Computing

iMail – children will use e-mail to send and receive messages. They learn about communicating over distances and how to use email safely.

**E-safety** – to explain how online identity is different from real life.



### Design & Technology

Using our whole school book, "What We'll Build", children will think about designing and creating packaging which protects and promotes a very special product. They will use a range of materials and evaluate different designs for their packaging.

### Geography

Children will focus on a history topic this half term in which they may use geographical skills such as map reading. They will be moving onto a geography topic next half term.

### History

Children will be exploring different aspects of Ancient Egyptian life including hieroglyphics, gods and goddesses and mummification.



### Languages

Children will learn to talk about their hobbies and interests in French.

### Music

Children will develop their own composition using the full range of body percussion.

### PE & Sport

In gymnastics, children will create complex sequences including a range of travelling actions and sequences. Outside children will develop competencies in key skills such as defending, attacking, throwing, catching and shooting.
