Summer (2) Term

English

Spelling

- Words with prefixes and suffixes
- Children will consolidate their learning of the spelling rules learnt throughout the year.

Grammar and Punctuation

- Conjunctions, fronted adverbials, direct speech punctuation, expanded noun phrases, relative clauses

Art & Design

During this half term, children will be looking at the work of Andy Warhol to develop their understanding of the Pop Art movement. They will explore how they can use digital media to help them create work in the Pop Art style.



Computing

In this unit children focus on developing computational thinking and programming skills to investigate angles and navigate mazes.

E-safety – understanding the importance of age-restrictions and recognising ownership of digital content

Design & Technology

Throughout this term children will be combining their learning about healthy lifestyles with investigating foods that make healthy snacks. They will explore a range of techniques for preparing simple healthy snacks.

Geography

Children will develop their geographical fieldwork skills during this half term. They will be thinking about the different ways that information can be gathered from the world around them and how the information they collect can be presented and used in different ways.



History

Children will focus on a geography topic this half term. During their geography unit they may think about how a place has changed over time and what the reasons for the change might be.

Languages

This half term, children will hear and learn the vocabulary for talking about the sports they play, expressing likes and detailed vocabulary for football and tennis matches.

Music

During this half term, children will enjoy hearing examples of rock'n'roll music and identifying what makes it unique. Children will then experiment with developing their own rock'n'roll compositions.

Children will focus on aspects of cricket, including having opportunities to work in collaboration with others, play fairly demonstrating an understanding of the rules, as well as being respectful of the people they play with and against.
