English

Spelling, Grammar and Punctuation

Design & Technology

During this term, children will continue exploring the design process from the market research and product development stage right through to production. They will evaluate, design and make healthy breakfast bar products and will include market research.

Geography

The focus this half term is on Fair Trade. Children will be learning about different places in the world that the foods and goods they use come from and how they, as consumers, can help to make sure that the producers in those countries get a fair



History

Children will focus on a geography topic this half term before moving on to a history topic next half term. During their geography unit they may think about how a place has changed over time and what the reasons for the change might be.

Languages

This half term, children will hear and learn the vocabulary they need to talk about the future. They will use the future tense and use adjectives to compare people. They will also use more ways to describe how they are feeling.

Music

In this unit children will learn what it takes to be successful in the pop music world. They will think about the elements of successful pop hits before combining these to compose their very own chart topper.

Inside, children will develop their racket skills when playing tennis, learning specific skills such as a forehand, backhand, volley and underarm serve. Outside, athletics challenges for distance and time will be set.
