

# Curriculum Snapshot



## Summer (2) Term

### English

#### Spelling, Grammar and Punctuation

- Children will consolidate their learning of the spelling rules learnt throughout the year.

### Art & Design

By looking at a range of works by artists including Cezanne, Monet, Van Gogh, Hockney, O'Keeffe children will think about how they can create 3D landscape images using a range of materials to create depth and texture.



### Computing

#### iApp (2)

In this unit, children will build on their prior learning of designing and developing useful apps with App Inventor.

**E-safety** – to know how to search for accurate information effectively, acknowledging sources.

### Design & Technology

During this term, children will continue exploring the design process from the market research and product development stage right through to production. They will combine aesthetic design taste and flavour combinations they have explored in food preparation.

### Geography

Children will focus on a history topic this half term in which they may use geographical skills such as map reading.

### History

Children will track the development of the great Islamic city of Baghdad including trading practices and everyday life and compare it with contemporary cities in Western Europe, learning about the spread of Islam through the Middle East and beyond.



### Languages

This half term, children will hear and learn the vocabulary they need to talk about different jobs that people do including naming a number of jobs in French, saying what they want to be when they're older and naming some workplaces.

### Music

Children will investigate some of the technology and techniques that are used to create the popular music of today. They will make use of modern technology to help them create their own compositions. They will also practice songs for a musical performance.

### PE & Sport

Inside, children develop the range and quality of striking and fielding skills and their understanding of cricket. Outside, children focus on developing the skills they need to play continuous rallies in volleyball.

### Religious Education

### Science

This half term, children will be looking at different aspects of healthy lifestyles for living things, including humans. They will also investigate the lifecycles of many living things including the process of reproduction which links to children's learning in RSE.
